HEMATOLOGY!

- Review <u>Learning Objectives</u> before lecture and quiz yourself after lecture / before exam to hone in on key ideas.
- Identify the key lab values / clinical features / diagnostic tools that differentiate the anemias, lymphomas, coagulation disorders
 - Making <u>side-by-side comparisons</u> (flow charts, compare/contrast graphs, Venn diagrams) can be a great way to visually ingrain these differences!
- Memorize <u>normal lab values</u> quickly recognizing which values are abnormal on question stems will help you identify pathologies quicker
- Find / create your own <u>mnemonics</u> for the different lymphomas and anemias!
- Draw out the coagulation cascade pathway with your own style!
 - Identify the steps where defects cause pathologies
